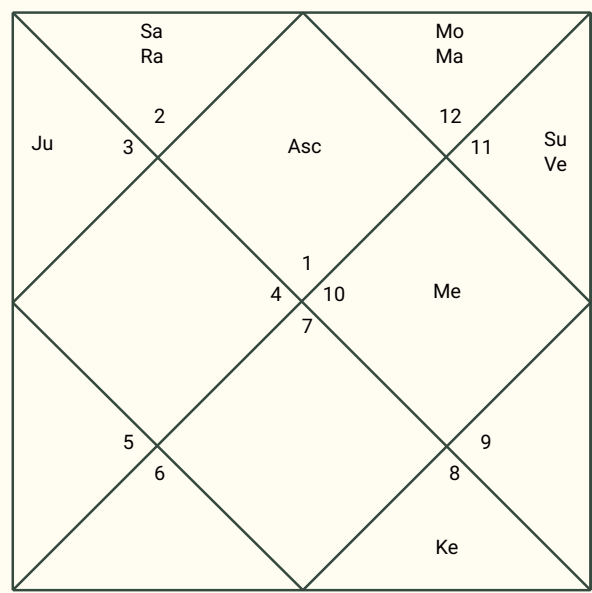

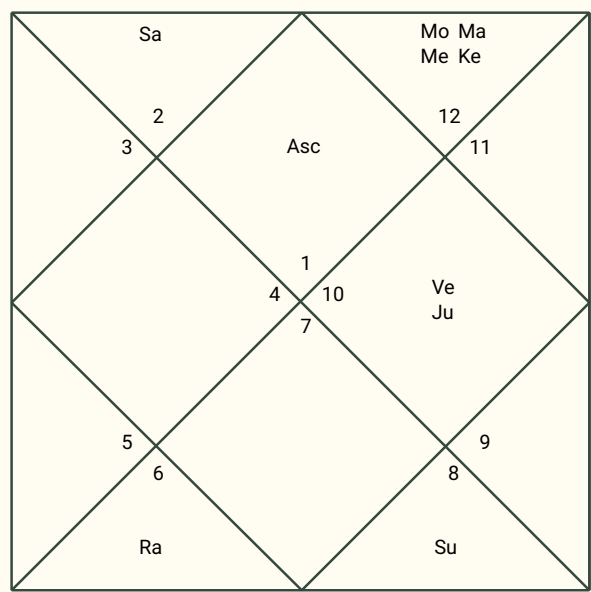

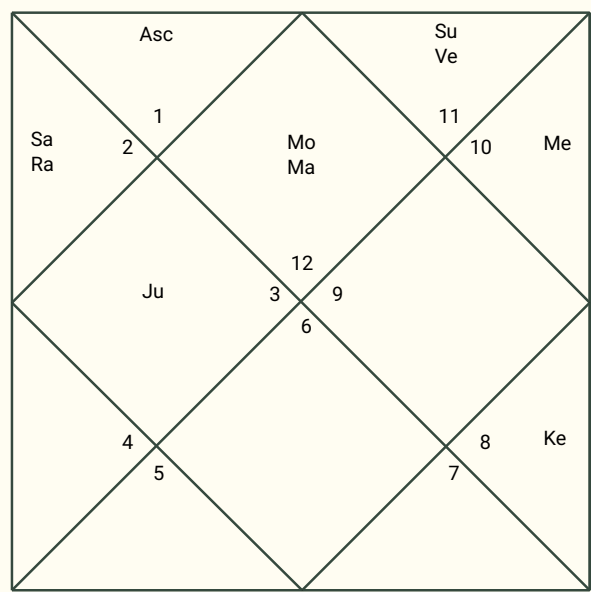
Lagna Chart

Sidereal Planet Positions

In vedic astrology, the determination of planet positions relies on the nirayana longitude, where "Nir-Ayana" denotes no movement. Here, the ayanamsa, the precise degree difference between the moving vernal equinox and the exact sidereal zero Aries point, is subtracted from the sayana longitudes used in western astrology. Amongst the different practices used for the calculation of ayanamsa, the method used here is chitrapaksha.

Vimsottari Dasha

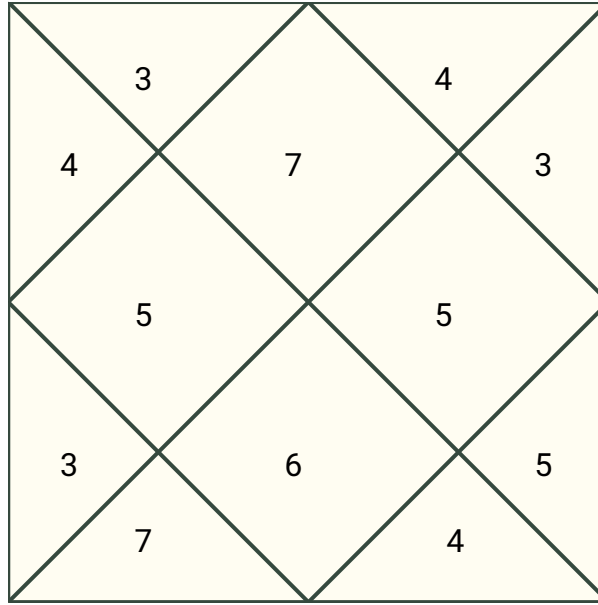
Vimsottari dasha is the most important and most supreme dasha as per vedic astrology. There are 9 dashas divided over a period of 120 years. Each dasha has a ruling planet and the life of a person is directly influenced by the nature of his/her ruling planet governing a particular dasha. The first Maha dasha is determined by the position of the natal moon in a given nakṣatra.

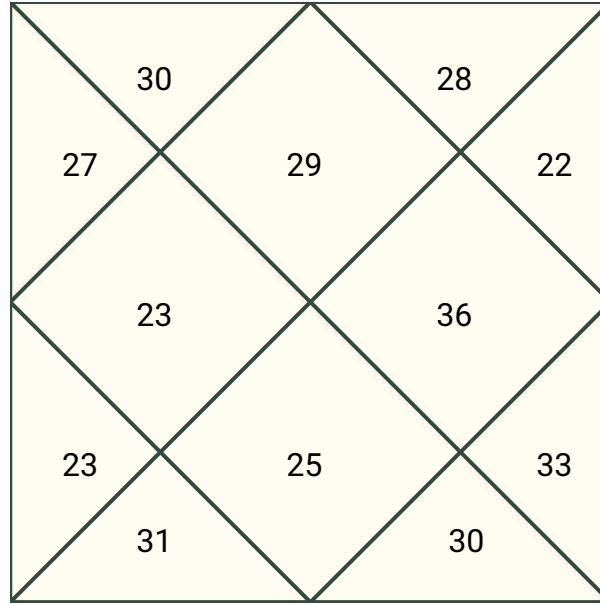

Analysis of Jupiter in your birth chart

Among the Navagrahas, Jupiter is esteemed as the most auspicious planet. According to the Brihat Parasara Hora Sastra, Jupiter's divine counterpart is Devraj Indra, the king of Devas. Regarded as a masculine influence, Jupiter presides over the ethereal element among the Pancha-Bhoota. Jupiter is esteemed as a symbol of Brahminical attributes within the caste system, embodying purity and wisdom. Aligned with the Satwik quality, Jupiter is characterized by its virtuous nature.

In its celestial relationships, Jupiter fosters friendly connections with the Sun, Moon, and Mars, considering them as allies. Conversely, it perceives Mercury and Venus as enemies, while maintaining a neutral stance towards Saturn.

Jupiter governs the zodiac signs of Sagittarius and Pisces, holding its highest potency when exalted in Cancer but weakened when debilitated in Capricorn. A strong Jupiter in an individual's astrological chart inclines them towards professions centred around sharing knowledge, wisdom, and education. Conversely, a weak Jupiter can hinder one's pursuits in these domains, impacting their ability to excel in knowledge-related fields.

In your birth chart, Jupiter occupies the 3rd house from the Lagna, 4th house from the Moon, is debilitated in sign of Mithuna, in the 2nd pada of Ardra nakshatra and Jupiter is aspecting the Venus in the 11th house

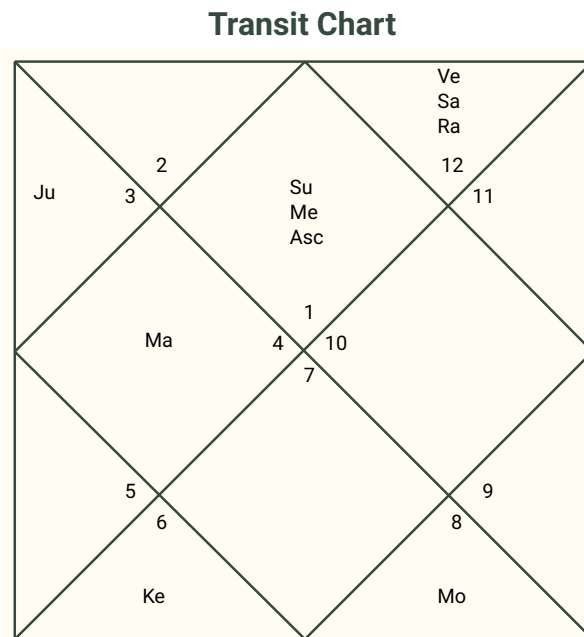
Jupiter In Third House

When Jupiter resides in the 3rd house, individuals may occasionally feel undervalued and cautious with their finances. Despite this, they have a prominent brother and may make occasional mistakes, harboring some negative traits. While they may not appear rich, they possess hidden wealth and are skilled at saving money. They enjoy a close-knit family with numerous siblings, possibly four or five. Jupiter Transit

In 2025, Jupiter will transit through two zodiac signs: Mithuna Rashi (Gemini) and Karka Rashi (Cancer). The transit charts, periods, and predictions for these transits are given below.

Jupiter in Mithuna Rashi



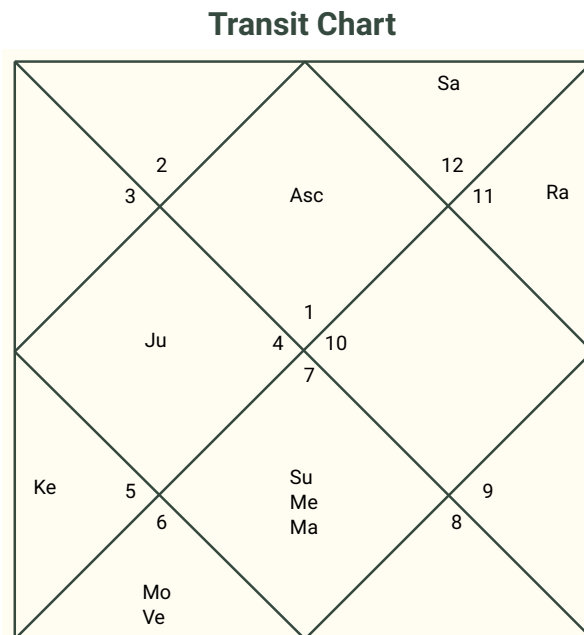
Jupiter is transiting through Mithuna Rashi from May 14, 2025, to October 18, 2025. This transit will be through the 4th House, counted from your Janma Rashi Meena. Jupiter is Rajatha Moorthy for you, resulting in a moderate reduction in the manifestation of these positive effects.

Jupiter will stay in Mithuna Rashi for 5 months and 3 days Jupiter will not retrograde in current rasi.

The next Jupiter transit is on October 18, 2025 when Jupiter will move to Karka Rasi.

The transit of Jupiter through the 4th house yields unfavourable results, reaching the worst at the midpoint of the Rashi. Since Jupiter is Rajatha Moorthy for you, the negative effects will be amplified slightly.

Jupiter in Karka Rashi



Jupiter is transiting through Karka Rashi from October 18, 2025, to December 05, 2025. This transit will be through the 5th House, counted from your Janma Rashi Meena. Jupiter is Swarna Moorthy for you, resulting in a moderate reduction in the manifestation of these positive effects.

Jupiter will stay in Karka Rashi for 1 month and 16 days and will retrograde once. The retrograde will start on November 11, 2025, and will end on March 11, 2026, in Karka Rashi, lasting for 3 months and 27 days.

The next Jupiter transit is on December 05, 2025 when Jupiter will move to Mithuna Rasi.

The transit of Jupiter through the 5th house yields favourable results, reaching their peak effectiveness around the midpoint of the Rashi. Jupiter is Swarna Moorthy for you, resulting in a significant enhancement in the manifestation of these positive effects.

Transit Prediction

Jupiter, unlike other planets, has a unique influence on the 5th and 9th houses, in addition to the 7th house, from the house it occupies. Below are the predictions for Jupiter's transit based on the ascendant (Lagna) and the moon sign (Janma Rasi).

Jupiter in Mithuna Rashi

As Jupiter transits through the third house, Parakram Bhav, Aries ascendants can expect a period of significant transformation. Governed by Mithuna, or Gemini and Mercury, this house promises increased courage and support from siblings. However, while gains from siblings are anticipated, they may be tempered by Jupiter's role as Vyayesh, the Lord of the 12th house. Despite this, individuals will manage expenses efficiently and receive aid from foreign sources. With Jupiter also serving as both Vyayesh, the 12th lord, and Bhagyesh, the 9th lord, there will be a blend of favorable and unfavorable outcomes concerning gains, employment, efforts, and relationships with siblings.

5th Aspect: As Jupiter is aspecting the 7th house, Sthree Bhav of Libra, governed by Venus, an adversary of Jupiter, individuals can anticipate significant but moderate success in matters related to employment and relationships with their spouses.

7th Aspect: With Jupiter casting its influence on the 9th house, Dharma Bhav, the native house of Sagittarius, individuals can expect a boost in their luck and fortune. They will be perceived as fortunate individuals and will uphold righteous principles and moral values.

9th Aspect: Jupiter's aspect on the 11th house, the Labh Bhav of Aquarius, governed by Saturn, suggests a potential rise in income for the individuals, after an initial period of struggle.

Jupiter Transiting Fourth House From Your Janma Rasi

During Jupiter's transit through the fourth house from Chandra Rashi, individuals may confront a range of challenges primarily centred around familial and domestic spheres. Tensions within the family can disrupt peace of mind, possibly leading to emotional turmoil and mental agitation. There's a heightened risk of accidents, particularly involving vehicles, adding to the stress. Individuals may find themselves unfairly blamed for various issues, further exacerbating their sense of unease. Mental instability and physical fatigue may prevail, with quarrels and speculation offering temporary distractions but ultimately leading to financial losses. Business setbacks, property loss, and estrangement from relatives during tough times are likely outcomes. Additionally, there's a potential for humiliation, injury from animals, and legal troubles stemming from false accusations. The transit of planets through Rashi yields both favorable and unfavorable results, contingent upon the individual's house placement relative to their Janma Rashi (natal moon sign), where the transit occurs. Occasionally, these positive and negative effects are nullified by the positioning of other transiting planets in particular houses relative to the Janma Rashi. When the positive influences of a transiting planet are nullified, it is called Gochar Vedha, and likewise, when the negative impacts arising from the transiting planet are neutralized, it's termed Vipareetha Vedha.

The anticipated negative effects of Jupiter's transit through the 4th house are nullified due to the simultaneous transit of Mercury, Venus and Mars through the 5th house relative to your Janma Rashi Meena, which serves as a 'Vedha Sthana' for Jupiter. This cancellation of unfavourable results is termed as 'Vipareeth Vedha'. The specific durations of the transits of Mercury, Venus and Mars that result in the cancellation of non-beneficial effects are given below:

Jupiter in Karka Rashi

Aries ascendants will experience this transit of Deva Guru Brihaspati in the 4th house of the birth chart, demarcated as the Sukh Bhava, and will bring about significant effects. Being exalted in Cancer, a sign ruled by the Moon, which is an ally of Jupiter, this alignment will usher on native, great strength from Mother and success in matters related to land and property. The native will be blessed with good fortune and will walk on the righteous path, gaining all kinds of domestic comforts and luxuries.

5th Aspect: Jupiter's aspect on the 8th house, that is, the Ayu Bhava, which falls under the jurisdiction of Mars, the Rashi Swamy of Scorpio, Brings strength to longevity and gains from hereditary property. This transit will not only bring peace and stability in daily life but will also enhance natives' knowledge and foothold in hidden knowledge and ancient sciences.

7th Aspect: The aspect of Brihaspati, on the 10th house of the birth chart, the karma Bhava, which is ruled by Shani, one of his enemies, may lead to some challenges in the father's well-being and career growth. The native is advised to remain overtly careful while dealing with government-related matters and while undertaking professional expansions.

9th Aspect: Jupiter's aspect on the 12th house, the Vyaya Bhava of Pisces, its sign, may result in an increase in expenses for the native. On the brighter side, this situation may lead to strong foreign relations, spiritual upliftment, inner peace, and a sense of fulfillment.

Jupiter, which takes nearly a year to transit through a single zodiac sign, does not produce the same effects consistently throughout the year. A zodiac sign comprises two and a half portions of Nakshatras, and Jupiter moves through these Nakshatras at various intervals, leading to fluctuations in the effects of Jupiter's transit. Moreover, according to the Ashtakavarga concept, each Rashi is divided into eight Kakshyas, corresponding to seven planets and the Lagna, in the sequence of Saturn, Jupiter, Mars, Sun, Venus, Mercury, Moon, and Lagna. Additionally, retrograde effects, Gochar Vedha or Vipareetha Vedha, and Nakshatra Vedha also play a role in influencing the outcomes provided by the transiting planet. Below are the predictions and corresponding dates for the aforementioned information in regard to Jupiter's transit:

Jupiter Transiting Fifth House From Your Janma Rasi

When Jupiter transits through the fifth house from Chandra Rashi, individuals can anticipate a myriad of auspicious blessings and opportunities. This period heralds the arrival of sons, along with material wealth such as vehicles, gold, and property. Monetary gains and lucrative ventures are on the horizon, ensuring financial stability and prosperity. Marriage and familial bonds are strengthened, fostering happiness and harmony within the family. During this transit, Jupiter is not affected by Gochar Vedha or Vipareetha Vedha from any other planet. However, the luminary Moon do cause Gochar Vedha during this period, with the relevant dates listed at the end of the report.

Jupiter transit through various kakshya

Each planet transits through a zodiac sign for a specific duration. The sign is divided into eight equal segments, referred to as Kakshyas. Each kakshya is ruled under the Lordship of a specific planet, following a sequence where Saturn, Jupiter, Mars, Sun, Venus, Mercury, Moon, and finally the Ascendant rule successively.

In the Bhinnashtakavarga of Jupiter, Mithuna rashi has 4 points. These 4 points are contributed by Mercury, Venus, Mars and Jupiter.

Since Jupiter will transit only through the first Kakshya, Saturn's Kakshya, during its transit through Karka Rashi in 2025, the Kakshya predictions and dates provided for Jupiter's Karka transit pertain exclusively to Saturn's Kakshya.

Mithuna: When Jupiter transits through the kakshya ruled by the Mercury, Venus, Mars and Jupiter, it manifests the maximum results related to the 4th House in the Mithuna sign.

Karka: When Jupiter transits through the kakshya ruled by Saturn, it manifests the maximum results related to the 5th House in the Karka sign.

During Jupiter's transit through a Kakshya with bindus in Ashtakavarga, natives can anticipate positive changes in their lives. Individuals may experience a significant increase in wealth, general happiness, and marital pleasure. This transit may also bring about an elevation in social status, with individuals gaining respect, vitality, and overall prosperity. The period is characterized by indulgence in luxury clothing and the acquisition of gold. Individuals may also experience a notable improvement in mental well-being, fostering a sense of inner peace and contentment. Additionally, this period is good for triumphing over adversaries and overcoming obstacles. Overall, Jupiter's transit through such a favorable Kakshya promises a period of prosperity, happiness, and success in various aspects of life.

Mithuna: When Jupiter transits through the kakshya ruled by Sun, Moon, Saturn and Lagna, it brings out only a portion of the results related to the 4th House in the Mithuna sign.

Karka: Since a Bindu is present during Jupiter's transit through Saturn's Kakshya, no adverse effects are expected.

During Jupiter's transit through a Kakshya devoid of a bindu, individuals may find themselves engulfed in misery as a result of experiencing a loss of wealth and intelligence. This loss can lead to significant mental distress, particularly concerning financial matters. Additionally, conflicts and dishonor through speech may arise, worsening the individual's troubles. Natives may also face challenges from adversaries. Excessive spending may become prevalent, worsening their financial woes. Despite efforts to improve their circumstances, they may find their endeavors futile, often leading to feelings of humiliation and false accusations.

Jupiter in Mithuna Rashi

In the Bhinnashtakavarga of Jupiter, Mithuna rashi has 4 points. These 4 points are contributed by Mercury, Venus, Mars and Jupiter.

During Jupiter's transit through a Rasi with four bindus, one can expect a period of regularity. During this time, there may not be significant profits or losses, and things may seem to be moving at a steady pace. This alignment suggests a balanced existence, free from changes in fortune. However, it is important to note that this transit may also involve experiencing meanness and ridicule from others, reflecting a phase of facing criticism or minor challenges. Despite this, the overall period is characterized by an average state without extremes, where stability and routine prevail.

First Kakshya

The transit of Jupiter through the Kakshya of Saturn will be challenging, since the Kakshya is devoid of Bindu. During this period, individuals may encounter setbacks such as loss of wealth, which could be caused by their tendencies towards greed or excessive desire. As a result, they may experience heightened feelings of sorrow and dissatisfaction. Additionally, engaging in negative or unethical conduct may worsen these challenges, further complicating one's situation. Furthermore, there may be losses incurred due to the actions of employees or servants, highlighting the importance of maintaining harmonious relationships and effective management practices. It's essential during such times to reflect on one's actions and strive for greater balance and integrity in all dealings.

The transit timings of Jupiter through the First Kakshya of Saturn are given below.
